Colossians 3:2 – "Set your minds on things that are above, not on the things that are on earth."




Congratulations to Monta Averill for having perfect attendance in Sunday School during the 2014-2015 church year. He is a member of the FBIC Class.

Trick r treat for kids and hotdogs for everybody


