Overcome fear with praise

As I think about all that has happened in the past month here and around the world, I am drawn back to a series of messages I shared with you back in April. The book of H a b a k k u k. I encourage you to take a moment and reread this book. It's only three chapters. This book tells me it's okay to ask God the tough

questions, and then wait on His answer.

In the face of great trouble, Habakkuk brought his questions to God. After hearing God's answer, he responded with a prayer of faith (See Chapter 3:2) He asked God to do great miracles because he was fearful.

Fear may fill our world, but it doesn't have to fill our hearts. Max Lucado says, "It (fear) will always knock on the door, just don't invite it in for dinner, and for heaven's sake don't offer it a bed for the night." Let's fill our hearts with a select number of "do not fear" statements.

The promise of Christ is simple: we can fear less tomorrow than we do today. 1 Peter 5:6-7 tells us, "Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, <u>casting all your cares upon Him, for He cares for you."</u>

What are some situations that could make you anxious or fearful today? If you are fearful, do exactly like Habakkuk did. Give them to God in prayer. Ask God to help you not be afraid, trust him, and have the strength to do His will.



blossom, nor the fruit be on the vines; Though the labor of the olive may fall, and the fields yield no food; Though the flock may be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stalls – Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation. The Lord God is my strength; He will make my feet like deer's feet, and He will make me walk on my high hills."

Whenever you face tough days, just give it to Jesus. Allow the God of your salvation to be your strength. He cares for you!






Dear Byromville Baptist Church Family,


Associational news
